

Privacy Policy

We will process personal data to provide fully underwritten or more accurate protection quotations and may also use the information for customer profiling, for dealing with future enquiries, statistical purposes, claims management and the prevention and detection of fraud. The data may be shared with: (i) our group companies (ii) the insurers and (iii) with other third parties where required by law, regulatory requirement or for the prevention or detection of a crime ((i), (ii) and (iii) together the Permitted Third Parties).

- a. any personal data being provided to us is provided in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998; and that
- b. each time you submit personal data in connection with the use of the UnderwriteMe intermediation services, you shall (i) ensure that all fair processing notices have been given (and/or, as applicable, consents obtained) to lawfully transfer the personal data to us and the Permitted Third Parties, and to enable us to transfer and process the personal data in accordance with the Data Protection Laws; and (ii) ensure the personal data is not subject to any prohibition or restriction which would prevent or restrict us from processing the personal data for the Purposes; and that
- c. all personal data provided to us is, to the best of your knowledge, accurate, complete and up-to-date.

Data Protection

Any personal data supplied will be treated in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998 and other legislation intended to protect your personal data and privacy.

Each of us (or your firm) will be processing personal data in connection with your use of this website and our provision of insurance intermediation services. The factual arrangements between us will dictate each of our roles in respect of the Data Protection Act 1988. Notwithstanding this, it is anticipated that each of us shall act as a data controller in respect of the processing of personal data, and we shall each be a data controller of personal data acting in common. It is not anticipated that we will act as joint data controllers. Further terms governing our respective roles, rights and obligations in respect of the Data Protection Act 1988 are set out in your (or your firm's) Intermediation Services Agreement with us.
